



CRAFTING WITH THE WOLOLS

Wolf mask and paws

For the mask you need, you will need

- Cardboard. Try to reuse an empty shoe box, cardboard box or whatever you have around that could work.
- Coloured pencils, black, greys and browns
- Scissors, glue and tape
- Elastic band

For wolf hands and paws, you will need

- Brown, black or grey gloves and socks.

No gloves or socks? No problem! Use the templates.



How to do it?

Cut the mask template, glue it or trace it onto cardboard to make it firmer and cut it out. Decorate it as you prefer.

Cut out along dotted line for the holes of the eyes.


Make two small holes on the sides, introduce there an elastic band, make knots at the end of each side. Now it will stay in place on your head. Well done!


From a leftover piece of cardboard, cut 10 triangles for the claws and stick them with tape to each of the gloves' fingers.

Cut 8 triangles for the claws paws and stick 4 of them with tape to each sock end (where the toes are.)

Now you can howl like a wolf!



Remember to clean up after crafting and keep your fantastic creations for future games





Make two holes on the sides. Introduce an elastic band and make knots at the ends.

They will now stay on top of your shoes or feet.



Cut out a strip of leftover piece of cardboard and glue it to the back of the paw so you can hold it pushing your hand through. You can also use an elastic band instead of a cardboard strip.
